The Bonifatius Centre is a school with the emphasis on language tuition and the integration of non-German children.

Tasks:

- Advising emigrant parents about the school opportunities for their 11 to 16 year-old children
- Our school is the first step for those who cannot speak German
- We help to select the right school later on Grammar (Gymnasium), secondary (Hauptschule oder Realschule), comprehensive (Gesamtschule)
- Tuition aimed at obtaining the necessary school leaving certificates

The Bonifatius Centre is attended by children who live in the Paderborn area and who cannot speak German at all or only insufficiently

Tuition is specially designed to meet the requirements of such children.

Study progress is individually monitored and controlled so that each child can learn as quickly as he or she can and indeed wants.

Younger children stay at our school until their language skills are good enough to successfully move onto classes at other schools.

Older children can sit their CSE exams (Hauptschulabschluss) or can also go on to do A-levels or go to a further education college.

The Bonifatius Centre offers the following benefits:

- We accept children throughout the year.
- Small classes with 6 to 15 children; standard classes (9, 10A, 10B) have approximately 20 children
- Intensive German tuition and all other subjects are taught in German too
- Specially designed English and Mathematics courses
- Successful schoolchildren can move to higher classes within a school year
- Assistance provided in career selection
- Intensive support when moving from school to work
- A social worker is available at school for children and parents
- Lunchtime activities (computer, homework, library, sports, etc.)
- Café and lunch facilities
